



## OPEN ACCESS

Seven of the twelve journals published by the Society operate under a hybrid model offering a gold open access option to authors on acceptance, while the *Transactions* is a completely open access journal.

An increasing number of authors can now publish gold open access at no cost to the individual, thanks to agreements made between their institution or funding agency, and the Society's publishers. These agreements cover the costs of publication without individual article publishing charges to authors.

All surplus income from the Society's publishing programme is used to support mathematicians and mathematics research in the form of research grants, conference grants, prizes, initiatives for early career researchers, and the promotion of mathematics.



The *Transactions of the London Mathematical Society* publishes leading research, welcoming papers of a general or specialised nature that represent a significant advance in mathematical knowledge, as well as submissions deemed to stimulate new interest and research activity. The journal is peer reviewed to the high standard assured by the London Mathematical Society for all its journals.
